How we use your personal data

Data is processed by Khembe's who are responsible for Return to Your Roots.

Purpose and legal basis for processing

Our purpose for collecting this information is so we can facilitate the event and provide you with an acceptable service and for marketing purposes. We will also use photo and video images on our website and other social media platforms, to promote our business. The images that we take will be used to promote Return to Your Roots and other events organised by Khembe's.

The lawful basis we rely on to process personal data of attendees, exhibitors and staff is Article 6(1)(f) Legitimate Interests which enables us to process personal data in ways that are necessary for our legitimate business interests and you would reasonably expect. Where we conduct direct marketing, we do this to inform you about services or events we believe might be of interest to you, based on your prior interactions with us. In this case you will always be provided with details of how to "Opt Out" of these marketing communications.

What we need

We need your contact and payment information to attend our events and your contact details for marketing details of similar products and services. During our events we also collect photographs, video images and audio.

Why we need it

We use this information to facilitate the event and provide you with an acceptable service or respond to your queries concerning the event. We also use the audio and images to promote our business.

What we do with it

We maintain details of attendees so that we can provide you with details of future or similar events. We use images and audio to promote our business. We don't publish or share attendee lists of our event

How long we keep it

We will retain this personal data for as long as Khembe's is trading and providing these types of products and services and for a maximum of 5 years. During this time, we would seek to update details on an annual basis and ask all attendees to inform us of any changes to their personal details.
